MEMORANDUM FOR THE NATIONAL SOCIETY OF PERSHING RIFLES

SUBJECT: Dues Payment and Policy – 20080915

1. The purpose of this memorandum is to outline the National Headquarters policy for payment of membership dues. As per legislation passed by the National Legislative Body during the 2008 National Convention, dues are a standard rate of \$30 per active company member.
2. Membership dues may be paid in two separate installments. The first half of \$15 per active member should be paid no later than (NLT) **Friday, 16 October 2008**. The second half, the second payment of \$15 per active rifleman, must be paid NLT **Wednesday, 18 February 2009**. NOTE: The Company may choose to pay the full amount at any time; however, at a minimum, the first half, \$15 per Rifleman, must be paid by Friday, 16 October 2008.
3. The first half of the dues payment may be mailed to the National Headquarters mailing address. Additionally, companies have the option of making the first payment at the Fall Commander's Call in Lincoln, NE. (16-17 October 2008). The second installment may only be mailed to the National Headquarters mailing address. Payments mailed to the NHQ may ONLY be sent via U.S. Postal Service. The NHQ Office cannot accept payments sent via FedEx, UPS, or any service other than U.S. Mail.

Payments must be in the form of one (1) check or money order made out to "Pershing Rifles NHQ".

4. Payment of dues is required for a Company to maintain active status in the National Society of Pershing Rifles. Any Company failing to pay dues by the first deadline of 16 October 2008 will be placed on probation or suspension, and any Company failing to pay dues by the final deadline of 18 February 2009 will be placed on inactive status. Any company placed on inactive status will not be allowed to wear any symbols or paraphernalia of the National Society of Pershing Rifles. Additionally, the Student Activities Office and the ROTC Department(s) of a chapter's respective University will be notified if a chapter is placed on inactive status.
