MEMORANDUM FOR THE NATIONAL SOCIETY OF PERSHING RIFLES

SUBJECT: Dues Payment and Policy – 20070927

1. The purpose of this memorandum is to outline the National Headquarters policy for payment of membership dues. As per legislation passed by the National Legislative Body during the 2005 National Convention, dues are \$100 per active company, plus an additions \$15 per active company member.
2. Membership dues should be paid in two separate installments. The first half of \$50, plus \$7.50 per active company member is due on **27 October 2007**. The second half, the remaining amount, must be paid by **08 February 2007**. NOTE: The Company may choose to pay the full amount at any time; however, at a minimum, the first half of \$50 per company, plus \$7.50 per person, must be paid by **27 October 2007**.
3. The first half of the dues payment may be mailed to the National Headquarters mailing address, or companies have the option of making the first payment at the Fall Commander's Call in Lincoln, NE. The second installment may only be mailed to the National Headquarters mailing address. Payments must be in the form of check or money order made out to "Pershing Rifles NHQ".
4. Payment of dues is required for a Company to maintain active status in the National Society of Pershing Rifles. Any Company failing to pay dues by the first deadline of 27 October 2007 will be placed on probation, and any Company failing to pay dues by the final deadline of 08 February 2007 will be placed on inactive status. Any company placed on inactive status will not be allowed to wear any symbols of, or use the name of, the National Society of Pershing Rifles.
